She is a four year starter on the girls lacrosse team. Jordan has been the team captain her sophomore, junior and senior seasons and has been their statistical leader each year. She has a 3.7 GPA and also serves as the Vice President of the student body and President of the Purple Craze, the school Spirit Club.**

**Additionally, Jordan gives much of her time helping to grow girls lacrosse. She provides lessons to girls from 7th grade to HS, coaches both an 8yr and 10 yr old team and has acquired her N.C. Lacrosse Refereeing Certificate and referees recreational league games.**

**Her Coach, L.J. Hepp states that Jordan "is a wonderful example of a high level athlete that serves as a leader in our school and community. She is a huge reason for the growth in our program." Prior to Jordan arriving, the school had only won 18 games over 11 years. HSHS won 5 games her freshman year, 14 her sophomore and was 5-1 before COVID 19 shut down her junior season.
