**Bobby Cremins is best known as the Bronx New York native that played at South Carolina under legendary coach Frank McGuire. He captained the Gamecocks and led them to their only ACC title. He then served as head coach at Appalachian State, Georgia Tech and College of Charleston. While at Ga. Tech he won three ACC Tournaments, was a three time ACC Coach of the Year and also won the Naismith College Coach of the Year.
