This week we are pleased to have as our speaker, Tim Stevens. Tim spent 48 years with the Raleigh Times and N&O covering all sports but is primarily known as the voice of high school sports. A Garner native, he was a storyteller and was more interested in people than in games. He wrote about character traits that were being developed in high school. His stories gained national attention and is one of only 6 people from N.C. to be inducted into the National High School Athletics Hall of Fame. In 2021 he was inducted into the N.C. Sports Hall of Fame. He is also a member of the N.C. High School Athletic Hall of Fame and halls at Garner H.S. and Broughton H.S.

He also helped write the original N.C. High School Record Book, researching outstanding performances in more than 20 sports. Additionally, he helped start the Holiday Invitational Basketball Tournament that has returned more than \$1 million to area schools. He continues to be very active in his community, founding a concert series and has written a series of plays about the history of Garner that have won the N.C. Society of Historian's multi-media award the past four years.
